Notes:

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A – Business Income

For a sole proprietor or if you have a side hustle - you will need to provide us with

- a spreadsheet tracking your income and expenses or print outs for your sales (POS or Store Front) and expenses usually spreadsheet is best
- bank statement for the first month and last months of the year
- your registered trade name (if applicable)
- your GST number (if applicable)

B – Moving Expenses

- Confirmation from employer for move (this is usually a slip they provide)
- All moving costs (cost of movers, hotels, gas receipts, meals, etc)
- Cost of rental while waiting for permanent residence (if applicable)

C – Rental Income

- The address where the rental is located
- List of owners and % owned for tax purposes
- Total rent amount for each property for the year
- All expenses for maintaining the property for the year (mortgage interest, property tax, repairs & maintenance, major repairs)
- D Legal Fees
- Legal fees associated with child support
- E UHT
- Do you own rental properties which may fall under the UHT tax? Not sure let's discuss
- F Joint ownership of parent / children's home?
- Bare trust filing may be required let's discuss
- G FHSA (First Time Home Buyers Savings Plan)
- Not sure what your limits are let's discuss
- H Bare Trust
- Have you co-signed a loan with anyone this past year? If so, we may have to complete a bare-trust return let's discuss
